October Breast Cancer Awareness Month NBCAM is an annual international health campaign organized by major breast cancer charities every October to increase awareness of the disease and to raise funds for research into its cause, prevention, diagnosis, treatment and cure. The campaign also offers information and support to those affected by breast cancer.



Columbus Day is a national holiday in many countries of the Americas and elsewhere which officially celebrates the anniversary of Christopher Columbus's arrival in the Americas on October 12, 1492. Since 1971 (Oct. 11), the holiday has been attributed to the second Monday in October, in 2019 it will be October 14th.

Halloween or **Hallowe'en** a contraction of **Hallows Even** or **Hallows Evening**, also known as **All Hallows' Eve**, or **All Saints' Eve**, is a celebration observed on October 31st.



Halloween activities include trick-or-treating, attending Halloween costume parties, carving pumpkins into jack-o'-lanterns, lighting bonfires, apple bobbing, divination games, playing pranks, visiting haunted attractions, telling scary stories, as well as watching horror films.[[]



The last two to three weeks in October (and, occasionally, the first week of November) are the only time of the year during which all of the "Big Four" major North American professional sports leagues schedule games; the National Basketball Association begins its preseason and about two weeks later starts the regular season, the National Hockey League is about one month into its regular season, the National Football League is about halfway through its regular season, and Major League Baseball is in its postseason with the League Championship Series and World Series. There have been 19 occasions in which all four leagues have played games on the same day (an occurrence popularly termed a "sports equinox").

Let's Trick or Treat Safely

Halloween isn't that far away and we want to make sure that your children have a very safe trick-or-treating experience. Here are a few tips to make sure your little goblins and witches have a fantastic time!

1. Trick-or-treat with trusted neighbors. Go to homes you in a neighborhood you know.
2. Dress like a ghoul, ghost, witch or super hero, but stay safe. Make sure costumes and candy bags or pails are reflective, carry flashlights or use reflective sticks and jewelry to be visible.
3. If you are driving during trick-or-treat hours, watch for children walking on roadways, medians, and curbs. Be sure to enter and exit driveways carefully. SLOW is best. It may take longer, but a fun evening can be stopped in its tracks with a trip to the ER.
4. Use well-marked routes to get to the candy. Sidewalks and designated crosswalks are your best route. Avoid walking across lawns as you can't always see what is on the ground.
5. Check all the treats before consuming and **When in doubt, throw it out.**
6. Know your neighborhood! Head over to sjsso.org and check out OffenderWatch to find out where the sexual offenders and predators are located so you can be sure to avoid those houses.



Peanut Butter Spider Cookies

Ingredients

1/2 cup granulated sugar
1/2 cup packed brown sugar
1/2 cup creamy peanut butter
1/2 cup butter or margarine softened
1 egg
1 1/2 cups Flour
3/4 tsp baking soda
1/2 teaspoon baking powder
Extra granulated sugar

Cookie Toppings

72 chocolate whopper balls
72 candy eyes
Melting chocolate

Preheat oven to 375 degrees F.

In large bowl, beat 1/2 cup granulated sugar, the brown sugar, peanut butter, butter and egg with electric mixer on medium speed, or mix with spoon, until well blended. Stir in flour, baking soda and baking powder until dough forms.

Roll dough into 1 inch balls then into the additional sugar. Put them 2 inches apart on an ungreased cookie sheet.

Bake 8-10 minutes until the edges are brown. Use a small spoon and indent the middle. Let cool on a cooling rack.

Once fully cooled. Pipe some chocolate dots in the middle of the cookie then stick the milk duds in. Add the candy eyes then draw legs coming out of the body. Let harden and cool.
