

**ST. JOHNS GOLF & COUNTRY CLUB ASSOCIATION  
AMENDED & RESTATED POLITICAL SIGNAGE POLICY**

As stated in the St. Johns Golf & Country Club Declaration, Article III Section 3.5 (b), the Association shall not regulate the content of political signs; however, it may regulate the time, place, and manner of posting such signs (including design criteria).

Accordingly, the Board of Directors by unanimous consent adopted the following addendum to the Covenants at its January 23, 2012 meeting:

Political signage size: No larger than the standard stick-in-the-ground size 24 in. by 18 in.

Number of signs: No more than 2 signs may be displayed in the yard at any time. Homeowners, if they care to, may change their signs daily in support of multiple candidates, but no more than 2 signs may be displayed at any one time. Signs in support of amendments, policies, etc. fall within the maximum number of signs.

Placement: No closer than 20 ft from any curb or sidewalk.

Duration: Signs in support of candidates or issues may be displayed no sooner than 2 weeks before any early election date and must be removed no later than a week after the polls close.

AMENDMENT NOVEMBER 18, 2019:

At the Board meeting held November 18, 2019, the Board unanimously approved amending the above policy to reflect that the **only** form of political advertisement permitted is the stick-in-the-ground signage as referenced above.
