From Architectural Review Board

Any changes to the exterior of your home requires submission of an architectural application and approval by the committee before any changes are made. Please remember that

service walls to screen trash cans, HVAC equipment, pool equipment, etc. have certain criteria:

- a) Service area walls shall be limited to a maximum height of 5' and must be constructed of materials and finishes similar to and in keeping with the construction of the house. Service area wall must be painted the same color as the house.
- b) Service area walls constructed of lattice, wood, PVC, vinyl siding or other materials not consistent with the finish of the house are prohibited
- c) Service area walls must be landscaped and shall not impede drainage between lots.
